

SEXTO SENTIDO

- The Sensual Voices of Cuba

SEXTO SENTIDO is the new "secret" of the Cuban music-scene representing a "**young generation of Cuban musicians**" with light, fresh and emotionally touching sounds, inspired by international styles combined with Cuban Jazz and traditional Cuban music.

With their sublime vocal harmonies they create an ambiance of melancholic melodies ("feeling"), mixed with dynamic latin rhythms, which they both dominate perfectly. Their ability to dwell inside complex harmonic arrangements transcends well beyond Cuba...

SEXTO SENTIDO consists of 4 young, attractive ladies (**Arlety Valdés, Eliene Castillo, Melvis Estevez, Yudelkis Lafuente**) and their own band (5 - 6 professional Cuban top musicians). The harmony of their voices is based on years of intensive training at the prestigious Cuban Music Conservatory Amadeo Roldán in Havana. They are singing together since they were in school. Their wide range of music includes Cuban, Brazilian, Latin-American and international songs - a mixture of smooth Latin-Jazz, contemporary R&B, Soul ("Feeling") and Bossa Nova - combined with Cuban Salsa and Son elements.

SEXTO SENTIDO soon created their very own style. Just after a few months of performing in the local music scene their name and reputation became a staple in the Cuban music culture. After their first awards at the renowned Havana Music Festivals (e.g. JO-JAZZ 2001, JAZZ PLAZA 2004 and CUBADISCO 2007) they became the leading entity of vocal harmony in Cuba. In 2004 they made their first record "Bossa Cubana", a collection of classic Brazilian songs with Cuban elements. Since then they are known in whole Cuba due to their frequent presence at Radio and TV.

SEXTO SENTIDO frequently collaborates with worldwide renowned artists of the Cuban and Latin-American music scene, such as **Chucho Valdez, Pablo Milanés, Silvio Rodríguez** and with members of the legendary **Buena Vista Social Club**. They have also worked successfully with worldwide renowned contemporary music producers like **Guy Sigsworth and Norman Cook ("Fatboy Slim")** on several dancefloor and house tracks for the London based studio NDF International (CD "The Revolution presents Revolution", June 2009, UK and Europe).

SEXTO SENTIDO were touring the world with concerts in Monaco/Monte Carlo (Casino, Monte-Carlo Sporting Club), Moscow (Tschaikowsky Theatre), Bulgaria, Croatia, Portugal, Chile, Angola, Mexico and recently Germany (ITB 2009) and France. Their talent promptly placed them as one of the preferred groups used at Cuban state functions, representing the new talent of Cuba, also at important international events (Latin-American Political Summit 2007 in Santiago de Chile, World-Aids Congress 2008 in Mexico-City).

Their 2nd own CD "Mi Feeling" was also released in USA (2008) and is still gaining airplay across important American jazz radio stations. It was voted one of the best jazz records 2008 by the renowned American LATIN BEAT MAGAZINE (Jan. 2009).

SEXTO SENTIDO and band will present their new CD in spring 2010.
